Plough Pub/Restaurant – Right out of Touring Park, right at crossroads onto Portsmouth Road. Pub is on the right. Dogs Welcome. Tel 02380 406214 www.ploughbursledon.co.uk

Dancing Goose Country Pub/Restaurant – Left out of Touring Park, straight across the crossroads and the pub in on the right over the Railway Bridge (10 min walk). Dogs Welcome. Tel 02380 456902 www.dancinggoose.co.uk

The Rollcall and Cottage Inn – Left out of Touring Park, left at the crossroads, left onto Woolston Road. The Roll Call is a short distance on the left. (Meals available Thursday to Sunday – booking advised – Tel 02380 452358 www.therollcall.co.uk The Cottage (old style Country Pub) is a bit further on the right serve food and watch BT Sports. Tel 02380 456310 www.cottageinnnetleyabbey.co.uk Dogs Welcome in both Pubs.

Price Consort Pub/Restaurant – Good homecooked food every day until 9pm. Left out of Touring Park, straight across the crossroads to the end of the road, turn left. The Pub is on the left, past the shops and before the Country Park. Dogs Welcome. Tel 02380 452678 www.princeconsortppub.co.uk

Mettricks Waterside Café – Left out of Touring Park, straight across crossroads to the sea. Turn right and follow road along the seafront. Follow road round the bend. www.mettricks.com

Local Places of Interest

(Directions – Walking/Cycling)

Hamble Village – (5 minutes by car) – Left out of Touring Park, at crossroads turn left, at T Junction turn left, turn right at the roundabout onto Hamble Lane. Follow the road to Hamble. Nice pubs and boutiques by the river. Catch the Pink Ferry to Warsash www.hambleferry.co.uk

Hamble Village - Cycle or Walking via Hamble Rail Trail – Left out of Touring Park, straight across crossroads, turn left at the T Junction. Follow Victoria Road to the Country Park. www.hamblevalley.com

Royal Victoria Country Park – (5 minutes by car) - Left out of Touring Park, straight across crossroads, turn left at the T Junction. Follow Victoria Road to the Country Park. Parking Charges apply. Large play area, miniature railway, museum, beach, café, woodland and open fields. www.hants.gov.uk

Royal Victoria Country Park – (15-20 minute walk) – Left out of Touring Park, straight across crossroads, and onto the path behind the bus stop on your left. Follow this path through the housing estate (railway line is on your right). At the end turn right over the road bridge and turn left past the front of Netley Railway Station into the Badgers. Join the footpath at the end on the left (not visible until you are at the end of Badgers. Follow to the end and turn right into the back of the Country Park. www.hampshireattractions.co.uk

Netley Abbey Ruins and Weston Shore – (Walk or Cycle) Turn left out of Touring Park, straight across crossroads. At the T Junction turn right. Abbey Ruins are on the right (dogs welcome). Continue along the road to Weston Shore. Putting Green at the end and often you can find an Ice Cream Van. Follow a gravel coastal footpath. There is 'allocated parking' at Dancing Goose Country Pub and walk through Westwood (Woodland Walk to the beach). www.hants.gov.uk

Local Shops

Tesco Extra – (24 hours except Sunday 10am-4pm) – Right out of Touring Park, right at crossroads, turn left at T Junction, straight across mini roundabout, turn right at the next mini roundabout.

Lidl – Left out of Touring Park, turn right at crossroads, follow road to Woolston.

KFC, Lidl, Costa Coffee, Greggs and The Range - 2 miles – Right out of Touring Park, turn left at crossroads on Portsmouth Road, turn right in Botley Road to traffic lights. Turn left onto Bursledon Road A3024 to the bottom of the hill on the right.

Local Shops, Bakery and Take Away Food in Netley Village – Left out of Touring Park, straight across crossroads to T Junction. Turn left, shops and takeaways are on the left. Chinese Takeaway (02380 452934), Fish and Chips, Indian Restaurant/Takeaway (02380 452314) free delivery. Turn left onto Station Road for the Co Op (open 6am to 10pm) and Post Office.

Post Box – Left out of Touring Park, left at crossroads, Post Box is a short distance on the right. Or the Post Office on Station Road, Netley Abbey (as above).

Hedge End Retail Park – Marks and Spencers, Sainsburys, Next, TK Maxx, DIY Stores, Pets at Home, Furniture Stores, Smiths Toy Shop, Fast Food restaurants, Car Showrooms – Turn right out of Touring Park, turn right at crossroads. At T Junction turn left, straight over 2 mini roundabouts. Follow signs to M27 3rd exit on roundabout, at M27 roundabout turn left and stay on the inside lane to Junction 7. Take 3rd exit off roundabout.

Whiteley Shopping Centre - Turn right out of Touring Park, turn right at crossroads. At T Junction turn left, straight over 2 mini roundabouts. Follow signs to M27 3rd exit on roundabout, at M27 roundabout take 3rd exit and follow M27 East. Turn off at next Junction 9 and follow signs to Shopping Centre.

Travel

Driving to Southampton – Right out of Touring Park, turn left at the crossroads onto the A3025 Portsmouth Road. Stay on this road to the Toll Bridge 70p off peak and 80p peak (same toll for car or car towing caravan). Not Motorhome.

Bus Stop for Southampton – No 6 – Left out of Touring Park, straight across at crossroads and the bus shelter is on the right. Every ½ hour (Change at Woolston for General Hospital **No 3**).

Bus Stop for Hamble – No 6 – Left out of Touring Park, left at the crossroads and left again onto Woolston Road, bus stop is on the left. Every ½ hour.

Bus Stop for Hedge End – No 6 – Then change for **No 15 – No 6** Bus to Hamble Square (directions as above) then change to **No 15** going to M&S and Sainsburys.

Bus Stop for Fareham and Gosport – X5 – Portsmouth X4 – Turn right out of Touring Park, left at crossroads, bus stop is on the right.

Netley Train Station – Left out of Touring Park, left at the crossroads at the T Junction turn right, the Train Station is on the left. Train for Portsmouth 2 mins past every hour, change at Fratton for Portsmouth Harbour.
